Policy Regarding Former Students

We are thrilled when former students want to return to say hello and tell us a little bit about what they have been up to since leaving RCS. However, we have so many students that want to do this, that at times it becomes disruptive to the teaching of our current students and is a safety issue for everyone in the building, including the former students.

Therefore, we need to lay out the following policy regarding these visits.

- Former students may visit the teachers at RCS after 3:30.
- If former students are walking to Redeemer in order to be picked up with a sibling, they must wait across Fifth St. in the parking lot just as parents do.
- If a parent of a former student is in RCS for some purpose and the student is under the direct supervision of that parent, then the student is welcome to be in the building with the parent.
