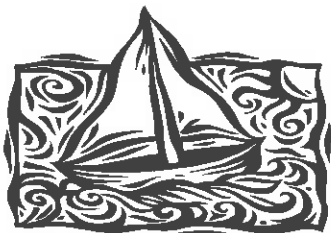
1. *Dork Diaries* by Rachel Renee Russell (any book in the series)
