



COVID Operating Guidance for K-8

Staying Home When Sick

Students should stay home when they are sick. They may return to school when they have been symptom-free for 24 hours with no medication. Students that come to the office who are sick may be asked to put on a mask to protect the staff and other students until they leave the facility.

Students with respiratory or gastrointestinal infections, such as cough, fever, sore throat, vomiting, or diarrhea, should stay home, and testing is recommended but is not required to return to school.

Positive COVID Test

If test positive: student must stay home for 5 days and mask for 5 when returning to school, but cannot return until 24hr fever-free and symptoms resolve.

If a Positive case is in the household, but the student does not have symptoms: The student must mask for 10 days or until symptoms develop.
