



Redeemer Christian School's Summer STEAM Camp Policy Handbook

It is the goal of Redeemer Christian School to provide a fun, educational environment for campers entering grades 1st through 8th. Registration to any and/or all of Redeemer Christian School's Summer STEAM Camps serves as a binding agreement to all policies held within this Summer Camp Handbook. Please read all sections carefully.

Before and After Care

Redeemer Christian School's Summer STEAM Camp will offer before and after camp care at an additional cost of a \$100.00 deposit fee for the entire week. The fee will be due at the time of registration. The times that will be offered are a morning block from 7am to 9am and an afternoon block from 3pm to 5pm. Each morning block will cost \$10 and each afternoon block will cost \$10. Parent's/Guardian's will be reimbursed for time blocks not utilized. This is NOT covered by the Afterschool Child Enrichment (A.C.E.) Program. Forms of payment accepted are cash and check.

Camp Offerings

Redeemer Christian School is offering several camps. All camps will be located within the Redeemer Christian School building and grounds. Register for one or all! Below you will find the name of the camps, a description of each and other details to help you decide. Camps are a first come first serve basis, and there is a maximum number of campers allowed. Once registered you will be immediately invoiced for services if utilizing the Afterschool Child Enrichment (A.C.E.) Program. If not utilizing the Afterschool Child Enrichment (A.C.E.) Program payment is due upon registration by cash or check.

Meals and Snacks

Parents/Guardians will be responsible to make sure your camper comes to camp with a bag lunch, a drink (refillable water bottle encouraged) and snacks. Water bottle refilling stations are available. Please also bring a towel as, weather permitting, lunch will be eaten outside. Redeemer Christian School's Summer STEAM Camp will not be providing meals.

Emergency Contact and Health Forms

Redeemer Christian School Students from the 2022-2023 school year will have emergency medical forms, emergency contact forms, consent to treat, and health history forms already on file. Parents/Guardians must make sure that all the information is up to date and correct on those forms. Parents/Guardians of new campers must fill out a Summer Camp Consent to Treat form, Summer Camp Emergency Contact form, and a Health History form in addition to the registration form before the first day of camp to ensure the health and safety of your camper.

Summer Camp Terms & Conditions

General Release:

I/We the parent(s) or guardian(s) of the minor child, hereby grant permission for my/our child to participate in all activities in and around Redeemer Christian School's Summer STEAM Camp(s). In addition, I/we hereby grant permission for my/our child to participate in activities, including, but not limited to those activities in the program description. Further, I/we agree to assume all risks and liabilities associated with my/our child's participation in said program(s) and to hold Redeemer Christian School and any of its agents or employees harmless from all claims which may arise as a result of such participation.



Photo Release:

I understand Redeemer Christian School may photograph my child during camp. Registration grants permission to use photographs in Redeemer Christian School's Summer STEAM Camp publications and approved media sources unless I request otherwise in writing.

Camper Expectations:

Redeemer Christian School's Summer STEAM Camp Administrative Staff reserves the right to decline the application of any camper, or send home any camper who, according to the Administrator's discretion, is disrupting the experience for other campers. **If a camper is dismissed due to behavioral/social issues, camp registration fee is not refundable.** If before and after care was utilized, the remaining portion of the \$100.00 deposit fee will be reimbursed. Please refer to Redeemer Christian School's Summer STEAM Camp Code of Conduct.

Transportation:

It is the expectation that the parent/guardian will transport the camper to and from camp. Campers are expected to arrive on time. No refunds or discounts to registration will be given to campers that arrive late or are picked up early.

Dress Code:

Campers must dress in an appropriate manner to participate in Redeemer Christian School's Summer STEAM Camps. Below is a list of guidelines. Redeemer Christian School holds the right to deem any manner of dress inappropriate and may ask that the parent/guardian bring an appropriate alternative for the camper to change into:

1. No sandals, clogs, or shoes with wheels. Shoes must be fully encircled— no open toes, open back, open sides.
2. Shorts are to be at a fingertip length.
3. Girls: if wearing a skirt or dress (at minimum fingertip length), shorts must be worn underneath.
4. No tank tops or spaghetti straps.



5. No mid-drift shirts will be permitted.
6. Sunscreen is strongly recommended. Recess will take place outside, weather permitting.

Refund Policy:

Cancellation/Refund Policy:

Camp fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Cancellations Due to Medical or Emergency Circumstances:

In some cases, refunds may be made for medical or emergencies only. A written notice of cancellation with explanation of medical or emergency circumstances must be provided for a refund request to be considered. Additional documentation may be requested by Redeemer Christian School's Summer STEAM Camp Administrative Staff. Partial or full refunds for medical or emergency circumstances will be at the discretion of Redeemer Christian School's Summer STEAM Camp Administrative Staff after reviewing the request.

Changes in Cancellation and Refund Procedures:

Redeemer Christian School's Summer STEAM Camp Administrative Staff may make changes to cancellation and refund procedures when considering the health and safety of campers and staff. No refunds will be given for campers arriving late, leaving early, dismissed from camp, or unable to attend all or part of a session.


Code Of Conduct

The following procedures will be used in handling behavior at Redeemer Christian School' Summer STEAM Camps:

1. We will recognize and appreciate GOOD BEHAVIOR. We will find occasions to thank each other for helpful actions, both on an individual and camp basis.



2. When campers are disruptive to the learning process, creative consequences will be determined based on the behavior of the campers. This will be handled individually by camp teachers and when necessary by the administrator. Communication with parents will be a vital part of this process.
3. At all times campers will be treated with the respect and love that they are expected to show others.
4. Willful damage, defacing to or destruction of school/church property will not be tolerated. All damage must be paid for, whether accidental or willful.
5. No running in the halls or on the stairs; only one step at a time on the stairs. Make every effort to walk only on the right side of the halls and stairs.
6. The use of profanity or coarse or vulgar language will not be tolerated.
7. Harassment, intimidation, and bullying of campers in the camp environment can substantially interfere with their ability to learn, perform, and feel safe. Therefore, any conduct, communication, activity, or practice that occurs at any time, on school property, or during any school sponsored event (e.g. camps) that constitutes harassment, intimidation, or bullying involving campers shall be strictly prohibited. Campers who are determined to have engaged in such behavior are subject to disciplinary action, which may include removal from camp. Further, any such conduct, communication, activity, or practice should be immediately reported to the administrator or other responsible camp employee.



Cell Phones and Personal eReaders/tablets/iPads/Smartwatches

Cell phones and personal eReaders/tablets/iPads/Smartwatches will not be used during the camp day. It is best to keep these devices at home. If any device is brought to camp by the camper, the camp instructor will have the camper place the device in a basket at the beginning of the camp day. At the end of the camp day the device will be returned to the camper.
